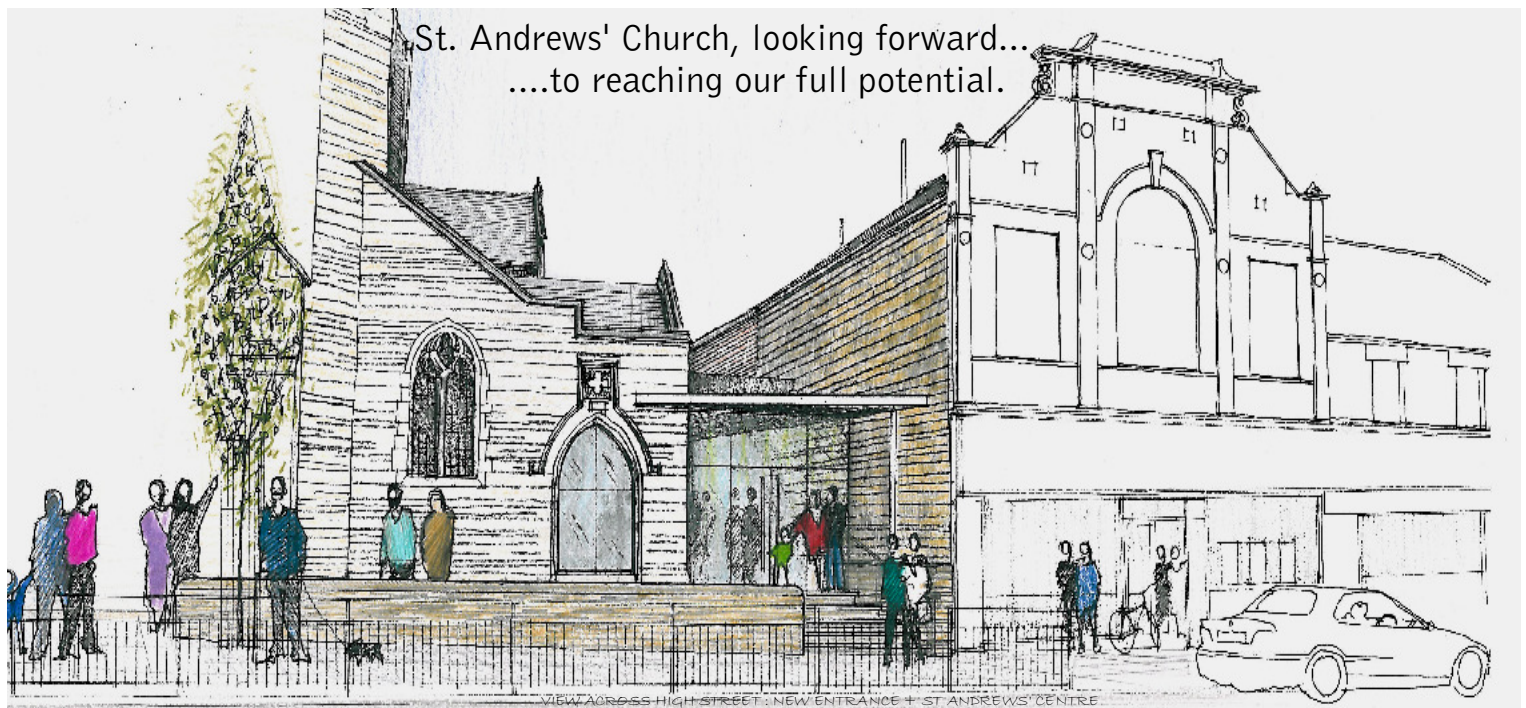

The way forward

"St Andrew's Starbeck, Church in the Community" is just that. The building is situated on the High Street just beside the shops and there are many local clubs, societies, groups and individuals who already use our facilities. Additionally the Church itself provides many opportunities for young, old, families or individuals that are open to all comers who live in the Starbeck Area, locally and further afield. However we know our buildings could be more appealing to the Community, could have better access into the building itself (particularly for the less mobile and parents with buggies) and could have better catering arrangements and toilet facilities for the users of the Church building. We also want to provide even more than the D.D.A. (Disability Discrimination Act) says that we must.

We are committed to serving people in the Starbeck area and to live up to what we as a Church believe – (we are) "under God's direction to equip everyone to reach their full potential in Christ." - Improvements in our buildings are a way of helping to achieve that.

Since 2006 we have been working with the local Community, our Church Family and users of our facilities. We recently appointed an Architect who has drawn up some Plans based on our Vision for the future and these are now on display in the Church building as well as on the Church website (www.andysonline.org).

The reality

These plans involve significant work and therefore cost, to create:

- An attractive Entrance and Welcome Area
 - "St Andrew's Centre" - for refreshments and meeting people
 - Accessible Toilets and Kitchen Area
 - Improved and larger Narthex area for crèche and meetings
 - Updated Office area
 - Re-oriented Worship Area allowing improved seating and visibility
- Estimated cost is £500,000

We hope to start Fundraising and detailed planning work on the Project in November 2009

Next steps

St Andrew's needs to move forward as a whole Church, with the opinions and involvement of people in the Starbeck Community being a major part of that.
